APPOINTMENT ORDER

In compliance of orders dated: 19-01-2026 & 05-03-2026, passed by the Honourable High Court of Sindh at Karachi in C.Ps No. D-6083/2024 & D-4549/2024, and recommended by the Sindh Police Recruitment Board (SPRB) in its meetings held on dated: 25-02-2026 & 01-04-2026, and consequent upon approvals of the Inspector General of Police, Sindh Karachi vide letter No. 1710-13/Estt/T&R/G.R-I/2026 dated:26-03-2026 & No.2168-70/Estt/T&R/S&S/2026 dated: 10-04-2026, the following candidates physical fitness/written tests were conducted through Pakistan Testing Service (PTS project SPD-480) and subsequently, interviewed by the Recruitment Interview Committees and have been declared clear in all respect i.e. medically fit by the Medical Superintendent of Police Hospital Karachi, verification of character / antecedent from Local Police, DIG CIA & Special Branch, Sindh and completion of all codal formalities, are hereby appointed as **Police Constables (BPS-07)** with immediate effect, with pay and allowances as admissible under the rules against the existing vacancies as shown against each.

Upon appointment, the candidates will be posted to the office as mentioned against each and will draw salary from their place of posting against existing vacancies. Their appointment shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The appointment is purely on a temporary basis and shall be confirmed upon successful completion of a three-year probation period as per Police rule.
2. The appointment shall be governed by the Repeal of the Police Act, 1861 and the Revival of Police Order, 2002 (Amendment) Act, 2019, along with the prevailing laws, Police Rules, and all other applicable rules and regulations.
3. The appointee shall undergo Basic Recruit Training Courses in accordance with Chapters 12 and 19 of the Police Rules, 1934, as well as any other specialized training programs prescribed by the Training Branch, Sindh, from time to time.



4. The appointee shall be liable for transfer and may be required to serve in any part of Sindh Province.
5. In case of resignation from the post/service without providing two months' prior notice, the appointee shall be required to deposit an amount equivalent to two months' salary into the Government Treasury.
6. The appointee must report to their place of posting and assume duties within **Fifteen (15) days** from the date of issuance of this appointment order. Failure to report within the stipulated time will result in automatic cancellation of this order without any further notice.
7. No TA/DA (Travel Allowance/Daily Allowance) shall be admissible for the purpose of joining duty.
8. The appointment shall be liable to cancellation if any of the above terms and conditions are violated or in case any false information or forged documents are discovered at any stage. Such action may also attract criminal proceedings against the appointee.

The appointee is required to report to their place of posting to assume duty and complete all necessary formalities.
