APPOINTMENT ORDER

Consequent upon the approval of the Inspector General of Police, Sindh, Karachi, conveyed vide letters No. 5692-95/ESTT/T&R/G.R-I/2025 dated: 22-07-2025, No. 1676-80/Estt/T&R/GR-I/2026 dated: 18-03-2026, No. 3758/Estt/T&R/S&S/2026 dated: 16-06-2026, the following candidates who have successfully passed the physical and written tests conducted by the SIBA Testing Service (STS) under Project SPD-01/2024, were interviewed by duly constituted Recruitment Committees. They have been declared medically fit by the Medical Superintendent, Police Hospital Karachi. Their character and antecedent verifications have been positively received from the Local Police, DIG CIA, and Special Branch, Sindh. Domicile/PRC certificates have been verified by the concerned Deputy Commissioners, Karachi, and educational documents have been authenticated by the relevant boards. All codal formalities have been duly completed. Accordingly, they are hereby appointed as **Police Constables (BPS-07)** with immediate effect, with pay and allowances as admissible under the rules against the existing vacancies as mentioned against each.

On appointment, they will draw pay from their place of posting against the existing vacancies.

Their appointment shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The appointment is purely on a temporary basis and shall be confirmed upon successful completion of a three-year probation period as per Police rule.
2. The appointment shall be governed by the Repeal of the Police Act, 1861 and the Revival of Police Order, 2002 (Amendment) Act, 2019, along with the prevailing laws, Police Rules, and all other applicable rules and regulations.
3. The appointee shall undergo Basic Recruit Training Courses in accordance with Chapters 12 and 19 of the Police Rules, 1934, as well as any other specialized training programs prescribed by the Training Branch, Sindh, from time to time.



4. The appointee shall be liable for transfer and may be required to serve in any part of Sindh Province.
5. In case of resignation from the post/service without providing two months' prior notice, the appointee shall be required to deposit an amount equivalent to two months' salary into the Government Treasury.
6. The appointee must report to their place of posting and assume duties within fifteen (15) days from the date of issuance of this appointment order. Failure to report within the stipulated time will result in automatic cancellation of this order without any further notice.
7. No TA/DA (Travel Allowance/Daily Allowance) shall be admissible for the purpose of joining duty.
8. The appointment shall be liable to cancellation if any of the above terms and conditions are violated or in case any false information or forged documents are discovered at any stage. Such action may also attract criminal proceedings against the appointee.

The appointees are required to report to their place of posting to assume duty and complete all necessary formalities.
