APPOINTMENT ORDER

In pursuance of the Sindh Police Recruitment Board (SPRB) in its meeting held on dated: 22-05-2026, and consequent upon approval of the Inspector General of Police, Sindh Karachi vide letter No. 3759/Estt/T&R/S&S/2026 dated: 16-06-2026, the following candidate physical fitness/written tests was conducted through Pakistan Testing Service (PTS project SPD-500) and subsequently, interviewed by the Recruitment Interview Committees and has been declared clear in all respect i.e. medically fit by the Medical Superintendent of Police Hospital Karachi, verification of character / antecedent from Local Police, DIG CIA & Special Branch, Sindh and completion of all codal formalities, is hereby appointed as **Police Constable (BPS-07)**, with immediate effect, with pay and allowances as admissible under the rules against the existing vacancy of **Traffic Range Office**.

On appointment he will draw pay from **Traffic Range Office** against the existing vacancy. His appointment is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The appointment is purely on a temporary basis and shall be confirmed upon successful completion of a three-year probation period as per Police rule.
2. The appointment shall be governed by the Repeal of the Police Act, 1861 and the Revival of Police Order, 2002 (Amendment) Act, 2019, along with the prevailing laws, Police Rules, and all other applicable rules and regulations.
3. The appointee shall undergo Basic Recruit Training Courses in accordance with Chapters 12 and 19 of the Police Rules, 1934, as well as any other specialized training programs prescribed by the Training Branch, Sindh, from time to time.
4. The appointee shall be liable for transfer and may be required to serve in any part of Sindh Province.
5. In case of resignation from the post/service without providing two months' prior notice, the appointee shall be required to deposit an amount equivalent to two months' salary into the Government Treasury.
6. The appointee must report to his place of posting i.e. **Traffic Range Office** and assume duties within **fifteen (15) days** from the date of issuance of this appointment order. Failure to report within the stipulated time will result in automatic cancellation of this order without any further notice.



7. No TA/DA (Travel Allowance/Daily Allowance) shall be admissible for the purpose of joining duty.
8. The appointment shall be liable to cancellation if any of the above terms and conditions is violated or in case any false information or forged documents are discovered at any stage. Such action may also attract criminal proceedings against the appointee.

The appointee shall report to his place of posting for joining and complete all codal formalities including preparation of Service Book, Opening Bank Account and HRMIS data etc. he should relieved to completion of Basic Recruit Training Course as and when selected by the competent authority, and after completion of Basic Recruit Training Course, he shall report back to his Place of Posting.
